World Wide Village, Inc. was recently blessed by a group of people in Brookings, SD who decided to do something creative and very tangible to help young girls in Haiti. Carol Harwood, the woman who spearheaded the effort, told us:

"Dozens of Dresses in a Day was one of those projects that took on a life of its own and is still growing. One day on Facebook, I saw an entry that mentioned how the [Real Hope For Haiti Rescue Center](#) needed help with sewing. I thought, "I can sew, maybe I can help!" My sister (a graphic artist) took my idea, created a phenomenal poster, recruited some help and the rest, as they say, is history!

On May 1st, 2010 over 50 women, young girls, and even a couple young men converged in our activity center and sewed 160 dresses for the RHFH children. The local newspaper and radio provided free advertising, and I was a live guest on the radio on several occasions. It was always a great opportunity for me to share the vision and work of World Wide Village and the Rescue Center.



At one point I began to worry that we might have too many dresses, but this was the response from Licia Betor, director of the Rescue Center:

'Wow! That is great news! Thanks so much for taking on this project for us! We are always in need and if we get too many (dresses), we promise to share with other places like ours in Haiti. So proud of everyone that gave of their time for this great project.'
